

The Fawcett Family

Ian and Julie Fawcett along with their two children, Loren (18) and Casey (15), are a Cottingham family. The family attended Christ Church for a number of years before Ian and Julie decided that they wanted to go into full time overseas mission.

Following completion of their theology training at St. Johns College, Nottingham, the family moved out to Costa Rica in 2006 for a further year of training. By Christmas 2007 the Fawcett's had settled in Choluteca, in southern Honduras, where they now live, working for the Gran Comisión Church. The Fawcett's work at the heart of the community where many people are desperately poor and a large number are infected or affected by HIV/AIDS.

The church has a range of community projects that the Fawcett's help to operate. These include a child nutrition clinic and Casa Hogar Vida, a large area of land which is currently under development. This will create a new community which will include orphanage houses with staff, housing for the poor, as well as its own cultivated land, where crops can be grown, harvested and sold generating an income.

A number of other activities are also hosted at Casa Hogar Vida, such as the ever growing Bible study groups and "Manualidades", a thriving group that make and sell handicrafts.
